

Additional Service Charge - £15 per week

We are required by the Government to clearly break down any charges made for your childcare with us.

To enable us as a nursery to run efficiently and successfully an amount of £15 per week per child will be added to your invoice each month if your child is NOT funded. If your child is funded we charge £1.00 per hour of every funded hour which is claimed through the government. This charge contributes towards snacks, gifts, ipads, Christmas, graduations, parties, sports days, trips out, bathroom supplies, ipads, downloads, FAMLy app and fabulous celebration gifts and cards throughout the year, this is by no means an exhaustive list but just some of the items that we provide additionally for your child. (see next page for further information, you are automatically opted ***in*** unless you advise on the admissions form

Government funding is to cover the basic Early Years Foundation Stage provision which includes such things as :-

- Small world figures, role play, puzzles, books and basic craft supplies
- Sand and water play
- Loose parts and construction toys
- Staffing levels that meet the minimum Government ratios.

The Government funding does NOT include :-

- Any food and/or Snacks
- Nappies, wipes, creams
- Suncream
- Soaps/antibacterial washes
- Tissues & nappy sacks
- Emergency spare items - clothes/wipes/nappies/creams/suncream
- Enrichment activities such as to the park, visiting the library bus, church, gardening, cooking, animal visits and any other visits we have to the nursery.
- Special events - Christmas parties, sports days, graduation days - including photos taken, gifts and activities.
- Festivals
- Additional high quality resources such as our mud kitchen, sand pits, bark area, baking supplies, vegetable growing and sensory equipment plus many more.
- Additional staff over and above the basic minimum, as required.
- Additional Safeguarding leaders.
- All staff Paediatric First Aid Trained.
- All staff Food Hygiene trained.
- Access to online FAMLy learning journal and care diary.
- Extra-curricular activities

If you choose to opt out you will be able to received your basic government provision only. We will also supply you with a list of everything you will need to bring in for every session your child attends. Please be aware that some sessions/days will need to be changed throughout the year, depending upon when our enhanced provision sessions are, we will give you a list of dates each time if you have decided to opt out. Our high standard of provision will not change if you have not opted out.
